
Forging Bonds Tri-Folds

The pocket tri-folds provide questions that make up the agenda for a breakfast, lunch, or one hour phone call. **Forging A Foundation** has the level 1 questions, **Check 6** contains the level 2 questions.




The purpose of **Forging A Foundation** is to build a deeper friendship among two or three Christian men who are meeting weekly for roughly an hour. They covenant:

- To be faithful in meeting with each other
- To create a climate of encouragement, trust, and safety in the group
- To keep what is shared in the group confidential
- To allow each man the freedom to not answer a question he considers too personal
- To be accountable to pray for each other during the week

The discussion questions include:

- 1. What has been encouraging about your week? What has been frustrating?
- 2. If you have been able to have some quality time with God this week, what insight from Scripture has stood out?
- 3. What has been the hardest part of being the spiritual leader at home, lately?
- 4. What spiritual battles can I help you fight by praying for you?



Check 6 partners are 2-3 best friends who know where each other's spiritual battles lie and who watch each other's back. They are 98% encouragement, but include the supportive accountability. Here are some of the questions that form the agenda for the hour-long breakfast, lunch, or phone meeting:

- 1. What encouragements or successes have you had this week?
- 2. What biblical insight or verse from your quiet time has stood out?
- 3. What needs of your wife are you focused on meeting right now?
- 4. What are you working on to disciple your kids?
- 5. Since our last meeting:
 - --Have you been too emotionally or physically close to a woman not your wife?
 - --Have you looked at sexually explicit material?
 - --Have you been praying for and seeking an opportunity to share your faith?
- 6. What spiritual battles can I help you fight by praying for you?
